- Minutes:** Steve moved and Mike seconded to approve the minutes from the March 12, 2024 meeting. Motion passed.

- Public Comment:** Question re the funds received by the department. Steve McDowell explained the funding process.
- New Business:**
- Property address signage for the community:  
Signed cost \$40 a piece from Wild Hare Signs.  
Steve recommended to the board that the department offer them to the community for free and assist them in setting them up.  
Donation would be accepted.  
Megan said this would help emergency personnel in locating properties. Steve will work on wording and get back to the board.
  - Fiber optic:  
The fee has been \$60/month and is increasing to \$109/month. So far the amount is still \$60/month
  - Designate Managers for FEMA GO and Website maintenance:  
Megan completed the paperwork for the FEMA GO grant and is on the account. Shelly will take on the grants.  
Website- Steve in on as the administrator and Dan will take it on.  
Bios for Mick McCourt and Shelly Wilkerson need to be added to the website.

Volunteer Stipends for call responses:

Stipends would encourage on call response; The board will have to determine method of payment either per diem or 1099. Mike will look into this.

The projected cost is \$2500 to \$5000. Dan suggested try it for 1 year.

Director education of CSD responsibilities:

Steve will arrange to provide information on how the department works; in regard to government reports, finances, and county processes.

Preliminary Budget for 2024-2025 fiscal year.

At the time there was no information from the County.

The budget from last year was review with no changes;

Dan moved and Mike seconded to approve the 2024-2025

Preliminary budget.

The following information was provided at a later date:

With no changes to the budget for this fiscal year, the total is 00\$52,780.

The parcel assessment fee is \$174.38. (2% increase from last year's \$173.40. There is also a \$2.50 administration fee to the County Auditor.

There are 224 parcels at \$174.38 per parcel x 224= \$39,061.12.

Old Business: 700 forms:

Standing Reports: Fire Department:

Megan reported they assisted Greenhorn with 2 structure fires but not many responded to calls.

She emphasized that having street number on parcels would be very helpful.

The fire department is working on getting more familiar with the area. James is working on getting his driver's license to drive the trucks.

Treasurer: Liability insurance of \$17,489 was paid for the year.

Current amount in the account is \$130,000.

Building and grounds:

CalTrans has not provided any further information on replacing the culvert on Little Long Valley Creek.

Still looking into a cover for the SUV.

Vehicle Condition:

Greg reported all are in good shape.
